The top-up service is supported through a 24/7 support system featuring state-of-the-art switching engine that offers billing, customer service, trouble reporting, credit management, settlement and reconciliation. e-pay's electronic top-up services are also available in Australia, New Zealand, Ireland, Poland and Malaysia.
