



Euronet receives money transmitter licenses to operate in key U.S. states – Texas, Florida and New Jersey

LEAWOOD, KANSAS - June 13, 2006 - Euronet Worldwide, Inc. (Nasdaq: EFFT), a leading electronic payments provider, today announced that it has been granted money transmitter licenses in Texas, Florida and New Jersey. With the addition of these three states, Euronet, within a year of acquiring TelecommUSA, has received licenses in 12 new states to provide its Veloz money transfer and bill payment services.

According to industry sources, the top six remittance sending states - California, New York, Texas, Florida, Illinois and New Jersey - represent more than 70% of the \$40 billion outbound money transfers sent from the U.S. to Latin America. These recent license approvals from three of the top six remittance sending states – Texas, Florida and New Jersey – has further expanded Euronet's money transfer and bill payment market opportunity. The company now has the ability to address approximately 40% of all outbound money transfers sent from the U.S. to Latin America.

"Compliance and regulatory requirements are getting tougher every day, so we're very pleased to receive approvals to operate in these key U.S. states. Also, we will continue to apply for licenses in the remaining states," said Michael J. Brown, Euronet Chairman and CEO. "Moreover, Texas, Florida and New Jersey match up nicely with our PaySpot retail locations and top-up customers. Our sales teams in these states are excited to now offer money transfer and bill payment products along with a host of other prepaid retail products."

Currently, Euronet is licensed and operational in 15 states for its money transfer and bill payment products – Florida, Texas, Washington, Alabama, Kentucky, Arizona, Kansas, Missouri, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Michigan, Arkansas, New Mexico and Oklahoma. In addition, the company plans to develop its retailer base in seven states where it has already received a license and/or does not require a license - New Jersey, Oregon, Wisconsin, Idaho, Montana, New Hampshire and South Dakota. To further expand its market opportunity, Euronet has license applications submitted and pending approval in California, New York and Illinois, among others, which account for more than 45% of the total U.S. outbound money transfers to Latin America.

In addition to money transfer, Euronet offers its bill payment services in all of its licensed and operational states. According to an Aite Group report, the walk-in bill payment industry, similar to the money transfer industry, represents a significant revenue opportunity. Aite Group estimates that in 2004, 500 million bill payments were made in-person by consumers in the U.S. and expects this market to continue to grow over the next few years. Consumers in Euronet licensed states can now send money and/or pay bills in 15 seconds using Veloz's unique, patented card-based cash-to-cash transfer services.
